What a year 2023 was! For the management team, staff, and volunteers at Maddie's Place, 2023 was a blur. Here are some of this year's highlights:

**Staff tripled from 25 to 77

**Dr. Randi Edwards became our first full-time Medical Director in September

**In May the 2023 State Legislature approved a 2-year \$5.5M Pilot Project for Maddie's Place

- **Pilot Project includes study by WSU of infant and mom outcomes at Maddie's Place
- **Maddie's Place featured in ABC documentary in November



**Phase 2 Remodeling Project completed this Summer **Department of Health doubled our license from 8 infants to 16 infants **Second nursery opened in November







**Maddie's Place received \$1M in funding from Coordinated Care in 2023

- **Maddie's Place received \$550K in charitable donations in 2023
- **Maddie's Place received \$95K grant from Health Sciences & Services Authority **Maddie's Place recently signed \$594K contract for services with Spokane County. Contract will hopefully be signed by the County Commissioners this month

Most importantly, the team at Maddie's Place treated 55 babies this past year and provided free room and board and wraparound services to 42 parents, most of whom were homeless at the time of admission. Finally, I'm excited to announce that Maddie's Place recently exercised an Option to Purchase .92 acres (i.e., 6 lots) immediately to the East of our facility. See area below in red. The purchase is set to close in 2024. The acquisition of almost an acre will enable Maddie's Place to continue to grow as the demand for our services expands. Our Board will be looking at the potential uses for this property over the next year. How can we best help our babies and our moms?
